Class Rule concerning maximum wind speed while racing

1. The decision to start a race or not is taken by the Race Committee.
2. The Race Committee should give as much importance to the sea condition as to the wind speed.
3. When the racing course is sheltered by some land, a start should normally not be given if the wind speed exceeds 24 knots on average.
4. When the racing course is not sheltered and there is some sea, a start should normally not be given if the wind exceeds 20 knots on average.
5. A race should be abandoned if the wind speed exceeds 26 knots on average.
