NOTICE OF RACE SIX METRE WORLD CUP

Organising Authority The Organising Authority is the Royal Swedish Yacht Club (KSSS) in association with the Swedish Six Metre Association (ISMA).

Jurisdiction

The World Championship will be sailed under the authority of a Race Committee, an International Jury and Measurement Committee designated by the Swedish Sailing Authority and approved by the International Six Metre Association (ISMA).

Rules

The regatta will be governed by:

- ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2005/2008
- Prescriptions of the Swedish Sailing Federation will not apply, except that SSF membership rules will apply to Swedish nationals only
- The Class rules and World Championship Deed of Gift, the Notice of Race except as any of these are amended by the Sailing Instructions
- The Sailing Instructions and its amendments. If there are any discrepancies between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the interpretation and decision of the International Jury shall prevail. English shall be the official language used in the Regatta.

Advertising

Advertising on boats or sails allowed according to ISMA advertising rules. Whilst moored, all yachts must fly the regatta logo flag on their forestay. A sponsor's pennant is to be flown on the backstay at all times.

Eligibility

ISAF eligibility requirements under Appendix 2 Regulation 19 shall apply to all competitors. Only international Six Metre boats holding a valid Registration/Measurement Certificate shall compete. Owners shall be current members of their National Six Metre Association.

The race committee can give the right for a boat to use a different letters and number scheme than its actual identification number.

Entries

Entry fee is SEK 5 000 or 545 €
The entry fee can be made by credit cards. Please state number of credit card (EUROCARD, VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Diners) and expire date on the entry form. Or via BIC through SEB, Stockholm, Sweden. IBAN: SE 52 5000 0000 0525 9100 1006 BIC: ESSESESS. Personal cheques or Eurocheques cannot be accepted. Swedish competitors, please, pay via BG 160-2861.
The fee includes one free launching and hauling, on arrival and departure, at Bullandö Marina. Entries (www.ksss.se) shall be sent in writing to the Royal Swedish Yacht Club, on the entry form prior to June 23rd 2005. A copy of the yacht's insurance certificate and current measurement certificate must also be included.

Races

Eight (8) races are planned. Five (5) races shall be completed to constitute a valid championship. If more than five (5) races are sailed, the worst result will be discarded. Three races may be sailed on Friday 29th in order to achieve a minimum of five races.

Courses

The racing area is located off Sandhamn and its vicinity. Chart 6144 (available by order from www.nautiska.se).

Jury

The Regatta will be sailed under the Jurisdiction of the Race Committee and the International jury appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix "N". All decisions of the International jury shall be final in accordance with rule 70.4

Scoring System

Low Point Scoring System (A4.1 RRS) will be applied to all yachts racing.

Penalties

RRS (44.1, 44.2) penalties system will apply.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Race Office on the day before the first race of the World Championship when registration is completed.
