NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is Royal Danish Yacht Club, KDY, together with 12mR Club, Copenhagen Station

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, except as changed by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Scandinavian Sailing Association and the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Standard rule changes occur in some of the instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open for all owners of Meter Yachts (6mR, 8mR, 10mR and 12mR), holding valid Measurement Certificates. Meter Yachts without Measurement Certificates can also participate in the regatta
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by 15th. August 2012

4 FEES

- 4.1 Entry fees: The target fee is again DKK 1000 (Euro 130) per person. The fee includes a complete social programme including all dinners, beverages, breakfast and lunch packets. The definite fee level will be communicated at the latest August 15th. 2012
- 4.2 The entry fee includes admission to social events for the competitors on all three racing days.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 Registration:
Thursday 6 September 1700-1800 Hrs. and Friday 9 September 0830-0930 Hrs at the Regatta Office in the club house.

- 5.2 Sailing:

- 5.3 After finishing a race a new race will be started soonest possible.
- 5.4 On the last day of the regatta no attention signal will be made after 14.00 hours.

5.5 Social activities:
Social activities will be included in the registration fee and will again cover events for all three evenings; detailed programs will be distributed a.s.a.p. at the latest on August 15th.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and present it at registration.
Organisers reserve the right to conduct measurement checks before, during or after any race.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration in the regatta office in the club house and at the official website.

8 VENUES

8.1 The regatta harbour will be Tuborg Harbour, Hellerup, Copenhagen. (55°43,6N; 12°35,2E).

8.2 Courses will be sailed on the waters north of Copenhagen.

9 THE COURSE

The courses for two of the racing days will be "Windward/Leeward courses".

The course of one of the racing edays will be a distance race with a length of approx. 20 NM near and in the Copenhagen Harbour. The race committee will inform the competitors at the daily skippers meeting whether a distance race is planned or the races will sailed on a windward/Leeward course.

10 SCORING

All races will apply. 12mR yachts will be scored by using the Baltic 12mR handicap rating, without the rating systems. Other classes will race as class boats in their respective classes. It is possible that a suitable handicap rating system can be used for the scoring in the different classes.

11 MOORING AND HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

11.1 All yachts must be moored at the designated berths in Tuborg Harbour. Free mooring is available from 28 August to 89 September.

11.2 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta from 08.00 Hrs. on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

12 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around the boats from 08:00 Hrs. on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee will use VHF Radio for communication to the fleet regarding the start and other race management issues. Apart from this aA boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded on a ratio of one per each five boats. Prize giving will take place at the regatta dinner on the Saturday or soonest possible after racing on the Sunday.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 2.000.000 per event or the equivalent.
